GOOD WORK ASSEMBLY

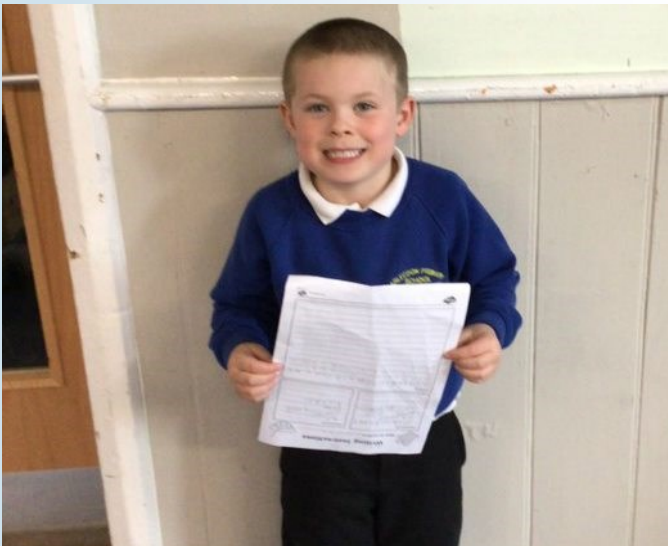


Each week children from each class are selected as 'Stars of the week'
