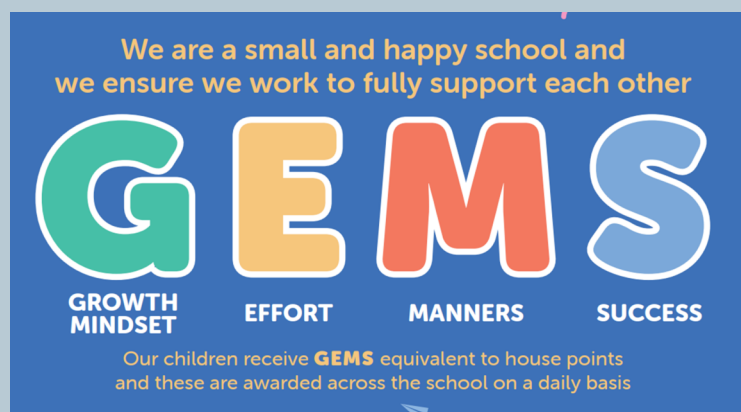
G – growth mind set

Boys outside the boys porch and girls outside the girls porch.

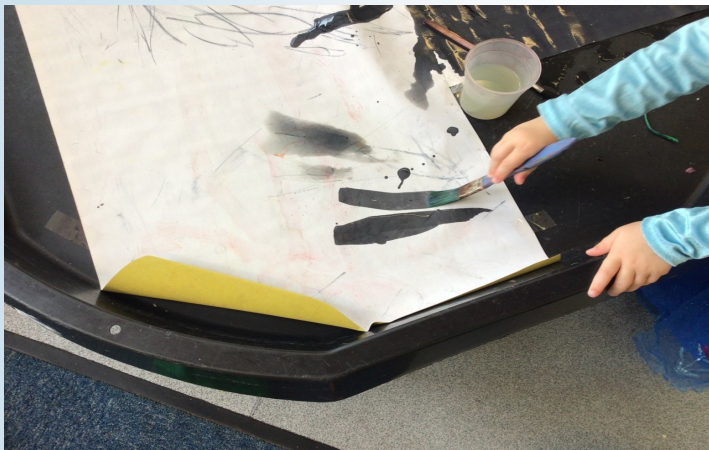
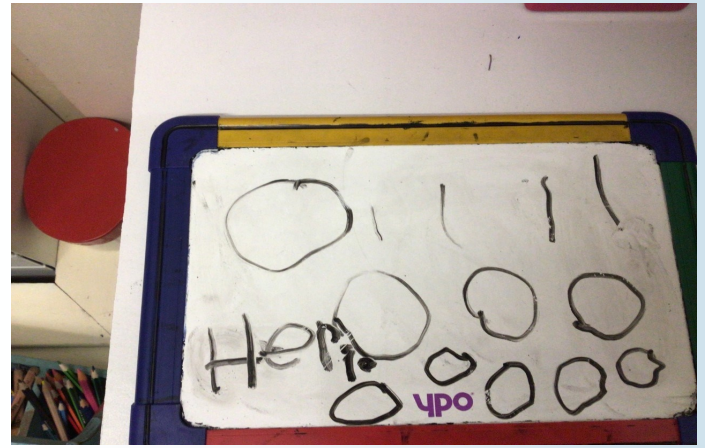
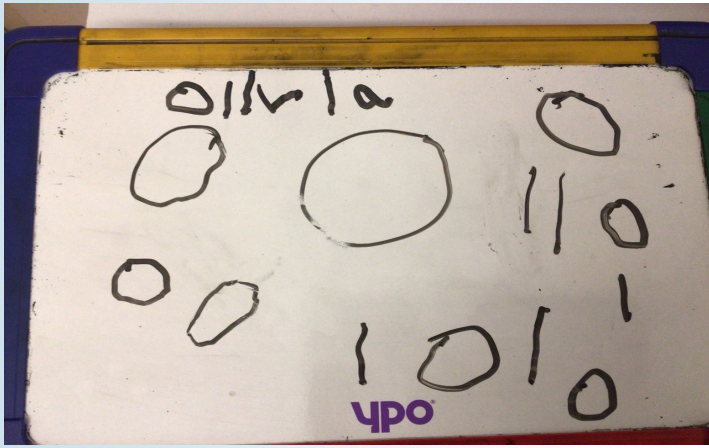
If you want your child to leave their bike at school overnight please contact the school office or Miss Jolliffe.
