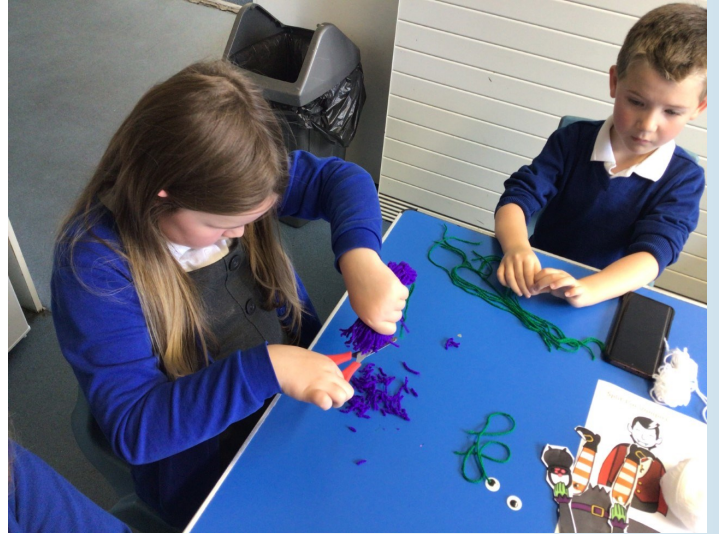

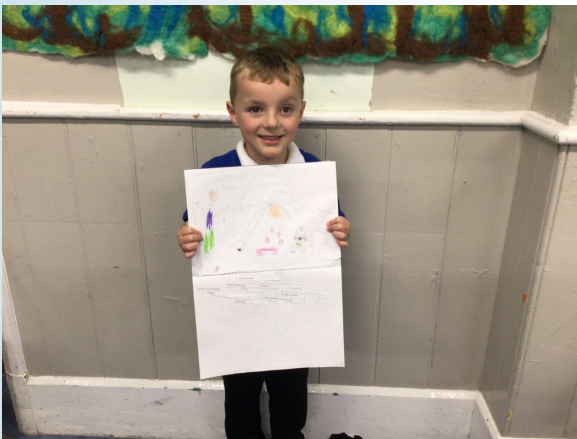
GOOD WORK ASSEMBLY
