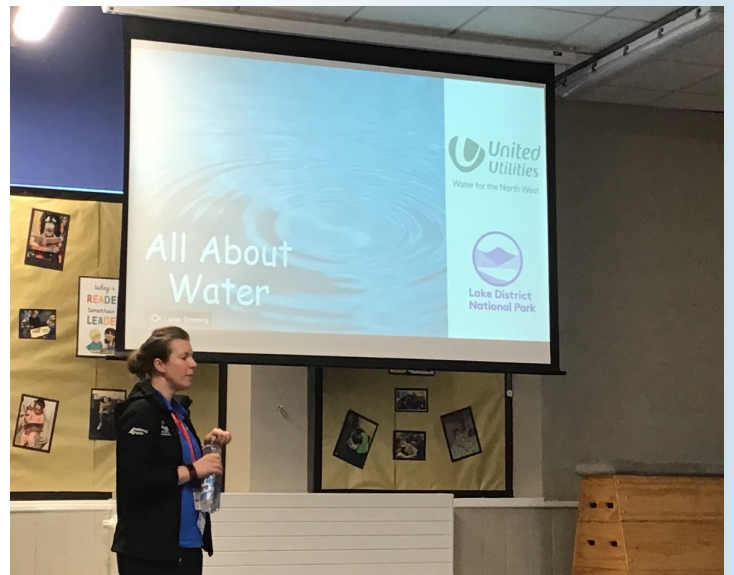
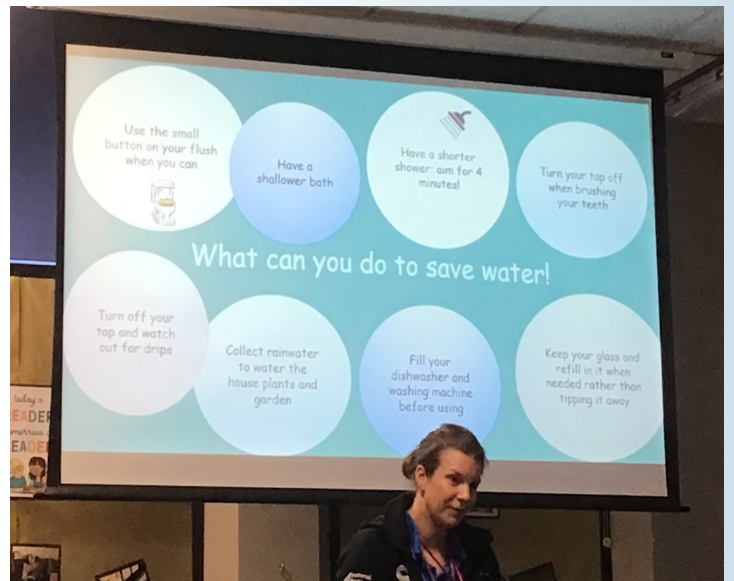
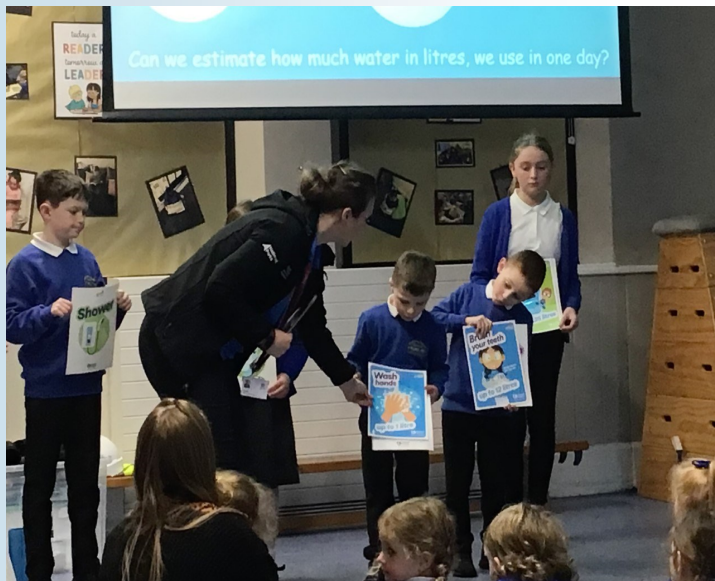


EYFS
